Your Comments: "I am concerned that at a time when the technology is moving to a model where the safety impacts are reduced such as fibre optic cables and Wifi links, the rules are not recognising this and are continuing to place what can only be described as draconian rules around these technologies which is directly affecting the rights of the Australian citizen, There are no electrical safety issues in running and terminating a fibre optic cable, there are no electrical safety issues related to a WiFi link. Yet both of these are being dealt with under S009. Any issues regarding network performance and compatibility for both these types of connection are not wiring issues but are related to the interfaces used when implementing these technologies, so why are they being regulated in S009? I am also concerned by the wording regarding the on site making of cables because NEC systems utilise an RJ61 format and I believe it is pretty much impossible to purchase a pre made lead in this format. Does this make it illegal to install an NEC PABX?"
